Sunday AM – Mother's Day

Pastor Joseph preached a Mother's Day message titled, "The Gift," from Ephesians 6:1-3 & II Timothy 1:1-7. Mothers are a precious gift from God, but more than that, the godly faith of a believing mother is one of the most priceless gifts imaginable. The Apostle Paul wrote to the younger minister, Timothy, and mentioned Timothy's mother, Lois, and grandmother, Eunice, saying that their faith had been instilled in Timothy. There is a sad mistake in the world today of people disconnecting from their ancestors. Sadly, young adults desire to do their own thing. Yet many of us are living for God today because of a godly mother. If you were blessed with a mother who bestows upon her children this gift of faith, be thankful. A faithful mother lives out her faith by trusting and obeying God. She never ceases to pray for her children. Her children not only see their mother reading the Bible but also living as it instructs. This bestows a gift of faith.

Pastor Joseph preached "What's In It For...?" from Matthew 19:16-30 & 20:2-16. Serve the Lord not with an attitude of "What's in it for me?" but with an attitude of "What's in it for God?" In Matthew 19, a pre-Pentecost Peter (not yet Spirit-filled) was concerned about what the disciples' reward for service would be. Jesus explained that our reward is not in this life, but after the resurrection. What's your attitude? Jesus followed that up with a parable of laborers in a vineyard. In it, a group of laborers negotiated their wage. The house manager agreed and thus *hired* them, but he later *called* others who did not negotiate; rather they trusted that they would be treated well. All those who simply trusted the house manager were paid better than all those who negotiated their own salary. The moral of the story is to trust Christ instead of negotiating to put a value of your own choosing on your service to God. Trust that the Lord will take care of you! Don't set the value of your own labor! Do not trust your own heart. Your heart will lead you astray. Trust God! We should desire to serve God, and thus we want to be healthy so we can do more for Him. We must keep our focus on God and working in His Kingdom. Keep your mind set on what you can do to help in God's Kingdom.

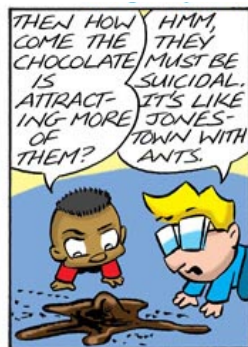
