## Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our ongoing Survey of the Book of Acts, under the topic of “Three Steps To Change Your Life,” reading from Acts 2:1-4, Hebrews 4:7-13, and Joel 2:21-23, 28-32. When Peter preached the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus to the crowd on the Feast Day of Pentecost (in Acts 2), the people eventually asked, “What shall we do?” Peter told them, “Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost” (Acts 2:38). One needs to identify with the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. (1) To identify with His death, we repent (become dead to sin). We must submit our lives to God. (2) To identify with His burial, we are baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. When we are baptized, we are buried with the Messiah “unto death.” Repentance **and** baptism in Jesus name are for the remission of sins. The old man dies and you take the old man to a watery grave in baptism in Jesus name. (3) To identify with His resurrection, we rise from the waters of baptism and receive the Holy Ghost, empowering us to live a new life unto righteousness. The infilling of God’s Spirit caused a regeneration our own spirit. We need the Holy Ghost to function and live up to God’s standards. The Spirit will lead us in all truth, causing a change in heart—and this is exactly how one can enter into God’s rest.

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph continued our ongoing Survey of the Book of Acts, under the topic of “In & Out” from Acts 5:17-32. If one is “of the world,” then he or she is *not* in the Church. Likewise, if one is truly part of the Church then he or she will not be worldly (not be of the world). Don’t let the devil divide you from the Church. The Holy Ghost is able to help us be unified as one church. Any binding situation that the world may put us in, the Lord can bring us out. The world will try to make us conform to its upside-down thinking and pressure us to back down and be like them, **but** we refuse to be like the world or think like they do. When the Holy Ghost comes in, He fixes one’s thinking. God’s church is to be in the world, but not of the world. God is in us. He has taken us out of the prison of this world and changed our “stinking thinking” and allowed us to have “the mind of Christ.” He fixes what is broken. We must trust God. His Spirit will lead and guide us.

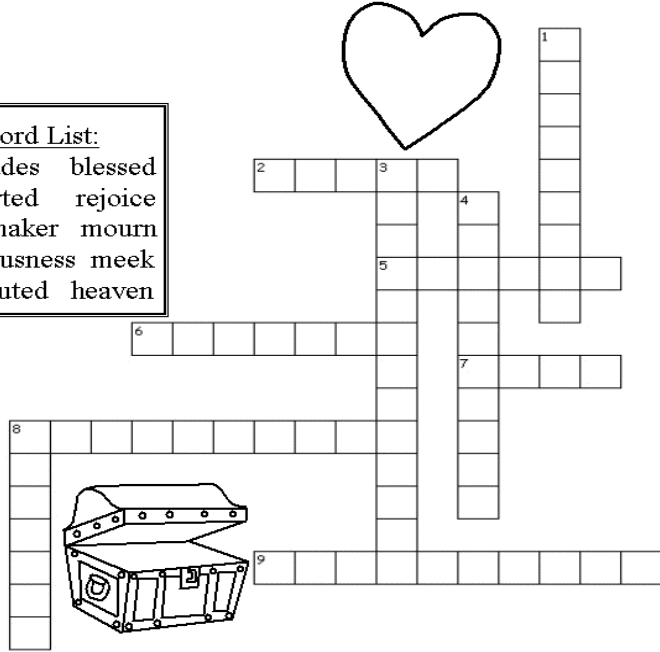

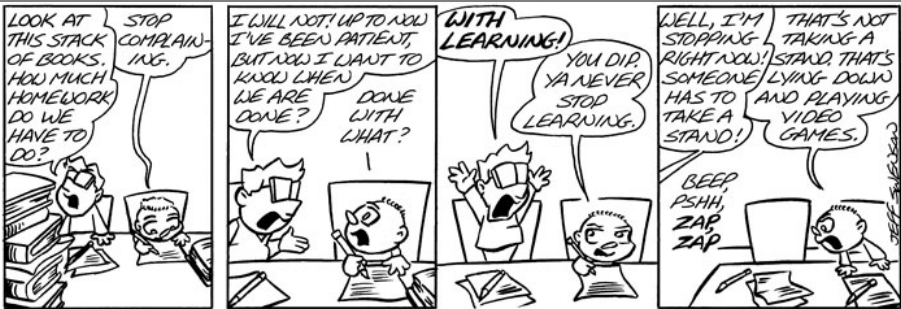
