Sunday AM – Father's Day

Bishop Daniel Garlitz preached "A Loud Voice From A Man That Didn't Speak" from Matthew 1:19-25. There were many characters in the Christmas story of the birth of Jesus. We hear of the voices of Mary, angels, shepherds, wise men, and the angel Gabriel, but we never read of the voice of Joseph. Joseph was a righteous man. The most important quality or characteristic of a father is to be a righteous man. Joseph knew what God expected him to do and he listened. Fathers need to know what God wants them to do and teach their children. We know what God wants us to do from (1) the Word of God, (2) by being sensitive to His Spirit, and (3) by obeying our pastor. Fathers, serve God every day. A good father is responsible, active in his children's lives, and teaches them values and morals of life. Joseph was a man of pure religion. Fathers, don't just *tell* your children how to live. Set a godly example. Be dedicated to make sure that your family gets to God's house. Instill faith in your children. Let your life speak to your children.

Bishop Daniel Garlitz preached "The End Is Better Than The Beginning" from John 2:11 & Ecclesiastes 7:8. At the wedding in Cana they had a crisis – they ran out of wine. Mary went to Jesus in this time of trouble. She told the servants to do whatever Jesus would tell them to do. We need to quit trying to figure out why Jesus wants us to do whatever, and just do it. Jesus told the servants to fill the water pots with water. Ridiculous! Yet it turned into wine that tasted better than they had at the first. When some people brought a blind man to Jesus, He put spittle into his eyes. Ridiculous! Yet the blindness was healed. Jesus wants to do something wonderful in our lives that may require something ridiculous from us. Just obey and believe! Jesus is interested in our everyday lives. He can transform any situation. God wants to bless us in abundance. We can have as much of God in our lives as we want. The end is better than the beginning. In this last day revival God wants to do the supernatural.

Elder Matt Anderson preached "The Way Up Is Down" from Matthew 23:12. God hates a proud look. You can live godly in some ways, yet still be an abomination to the Lord if you have pride in your heart.
