Sunday AM – Survey of the Book of Acts, continued

Pastor Joseph preached “When Heaven Speaks Thrice” from Acts 10:6-16. God is no respecter of persons. Godliness matters, not nationality. The Apostle Peter was shown a vision of animals and was told to kill and eat them. Peter declined, calling them unclean. A voice spoke to him to not call unclean what God has cleaned. This was done thrice, signifying its great important. The food represented people. Clean represented saved, and unclean represented unsaved. Previously it had been such than non-Jews had to become Jewish to be saved. In the New Covenant, God wrought a change, allowing unsaved to become saved, without having to become Jewish. God made a way for people of every nation to be saved, if they fear God and work righteousness, and obey the Gospel. Peter obediently preached the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus unto the Gentiles. God honored repentance, and poured His Spirit on them all. Peter then commanded water baptism in Jesus name.

Sunday PM – Survey of the Book of Acts, continued

Pastor Joseph preached “Open Doors & Broken Chains” from Acts 12:6-10. God never makes a mistake. He knows what He is doing. He exists past, present, and future. King Herod had James (brother of John) killed. That pleased the people, so he then had Peter arrested, bound with chains and guarded by soldiers. Peter was to be brought forth after Passover. We may wonder why God works as He does, but He does all things well. The night before Peter’s doom, a light shined in the prison and an angel appeared. Peter’s chains fell off and the angel led him out of the prison. Locked doors opened on their own. Amazing! When Herod found out the soldiers had let Peter escape, he commanded their execution. Yet it was Herod who faced judgment; he was smitten dead. Don’t judge God for what He’s done, because He alone knows what the future holds. If you feel tormented or bound, God can make the chains break and doors open for you. He can do the impossible!

Jr. Elder Kieran Joseph preached “On His Mark, Get Set, Go” from Hebrews 12:1-2 & I Corinthians 9:24-27. In life we are all in a race. If our goal is to make it to Heaven, we must repent, be baptized in Jesus’ name and receive the Holy Ghost. That is just the start. 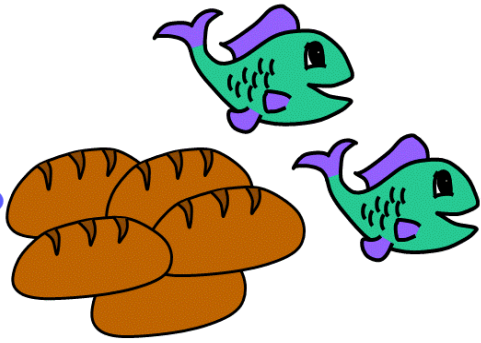

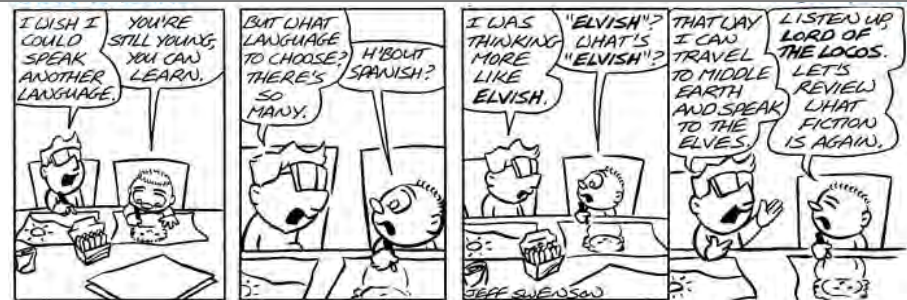
