Sunday AM – continuing our Survey of the Book of Acts

Pastor Joseph taught from Acts 13 under the title "But God." The terms *Messiah* (from Hebrew) and *Christ* (from Greek) both mean "Anointed." People mistakenly think the term applies only to Jesus, but biblically it is also used for other human deliverers sent by God. However, the man Jesus was *the* "Anointed One" in a unique way: He is the fulfillment of prophecies about an Anointed One to be synonymous with God Himself. Jesus is the express image of God, i.e. human manifestation of God. When we worship Jesus we worship the one true God. Jesus is a new federal head of humanity, replacing the failed Adam. "Jesus" was literally the Father's name before it was the Son's name (John 5:43). To see Jesus is to see God the Father (John 14:9). In Jesus, God and man were united as one person (John 10:30). Jesus is the Yahweh of the Old Testament, become our Savior. The name Jesus means "Yahweh-Savior." Jesus is the one name to fulfill Mat. 28:19. On Paul's first missionary journey, he preached the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus, and cited Messianic prophecies as fulfilled in Jesus. In Him we have life!

Pastor Joseph preached "A Friend in High – and Low – Places" from Isaiah 57:15, Luke 18:9-14, & Acts 17:26. God dwells on high, but also with those who are lowly & humble. The Bible disproves the notion that some races are intrinsically superior to others. God made all nations from one blood (Adam). All humans are born of equal standing, regardless of skin color, nationality, or ethnicity. We ought to humble ourselves, give Him thanks, and exalt Him. Abraham was a friend of God (James 2:23). We can also be friends of God. God dwells with those of a contrite and humble spirit. Stay humble. Don't think you are better than others. We don't look down on sinners. Rather, we desire for others to live holy as we do, and also receive the same blessings that we have.


