### Sunday AM — Church at the Park — annual Sunday School Picnic

Pastor Joseph preached from Joel 2:23-32 & Acts 2:1-4, 16-21 & 36-39. Biblically, the initial sign or evidence of the Holy Ghost baptism is speaking in an unknown language as the Spirit gives the utterance. In Acts 2, there were Jewish people “from every nation” staying in Jerusalem because of the Feast of Pentecost. They heard the disciples speak in their languages and were amazed. Peter preached to them the death, burial & resurrection of Jesus Christ. He said, “Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost” (Acts 2:38). Jesus said, “Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God” (John 3:5). To be born of water is to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. To be born of the Spirit is to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost. When the Holy Ghost was first poured out there were three signs: (1) a sound from Heaven as of a rushing, mighty wind. (2) Cloven tongues like as of fire sat upon each of them. (3) They began to speak with other tongues. However, for the rest of Acts, only one sign was consistent (tongues). Before the Messiah was conceived in Mary, God’s glory dwelt in the Tabernacle. God then “tabernacled” in Christ. Since Pentecost, God also “dwells” in those who have the Holy Ghost. When seeking God’s Spirit, seek Him, not the sign. Keep your focus on Jesus! He will pour out His Spirit!

### Wednesday

Elder Kieran Joseph preached “A Painful Call To Prayer” from Mark 11:15-17. In times of desolation you may ask God “Why am I going through this?” God is calling you to a deeper level of prayer. There are two things wrong with our culture today: a fear of silence and a fear of pain. People tend to need some kind of noise in their ears at all times. Yet it’s in the silence when God can speak to us. People are afraid of pain. They like what’s easy and convenient in life. Yet the pain of loneliness is a call to powerful prayer. We need a daily, private, prayer life. We must not forsake praying, fasting, reading our Bible. God is calling us to prayer. Convenience will destroy your prayer life but pain produces it. Elder Hannah Sandy preached “But That’s None Of My Business” from I Corinthians 12:12-26. Too often believers gossip and murmur about one another. If we aren’t careful, what starts as one comment (and adding “*but that’s none of my business*”) will turn into a raging storm. Suddenly everyone near you knows all about it, and in an exaggerated version! Be careful! Be diligent! Our words can hurt people deeply. Our tongue is an unruly member. No one can tame it but God. We need to be mindful of the people about us when we say or do something.

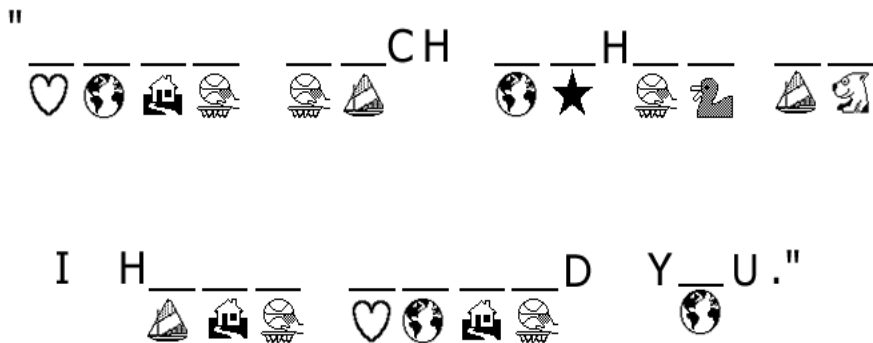
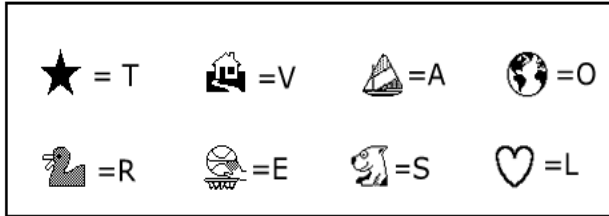

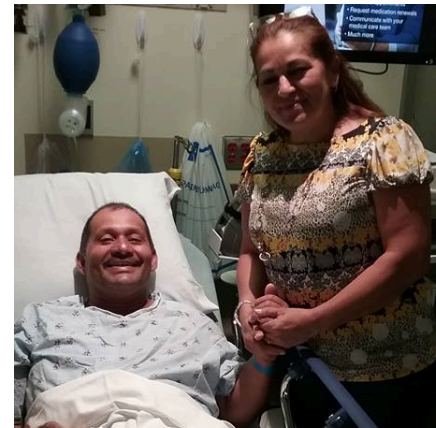
