### Sunday AM - Survey of the Book of Acts continued, with chapter 17

Pastor Joseph's title was "Noble Bereans." He launched from Revelation 5:9-10. All people are created equal, and all are related (all descended from Adam & Eve, as well as from Noah's family). Regardless of skin color, language, etc., we are all one people. As Paul came to new towns on his missionary trips, he would go first to the Jewish synagogue and reason from the scriptures, until he got either revival or riot (often both). The Jews of Thessalonica were less noble; they ignored the truth and started a riot. Those of Berea were nobler. They accepted the challenge to their concept of Messiah, and searched the Scriptures daily to see if Paul was telling the truth. We should all be "Berean" and seek truth. Study the Bible for yourself. Later on, when Paul saw idol worship in Athens, he preached unto them the only true God—the One who made the heavens and the earth. Preaching the Creation (from Genesis) is essential to truth and to the gospel; if Adam and Eve (and their sin) are not literally historical, then you don't believe Jesus's words about it, and you have thrown out the biblical reason for why we need salvation.

### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Filled With The Spirit" from Acts 2:1-4, 3:16-20, & 4:7-31. We are living in perilous times. We are living in a day of great wickedness. We ought not live by our own strength. We need to receive a touch during times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord. Even if you've been filled with the Holy Ghost for years, we all must be filled with the Holy Ghost daily, on an ongoing basis. God can give us boldness to speak against evil. He can give us boldness to stand against the anti-Christ spirit of this day. The spirit of iniquity is at work in this world and we must stand against it. The sanctity of life is being attacked. This is no time to be timid or living by our own logic and strength. We must have the anointing of the Holy Ghost. Be filled with the Holy Ghost! We must have a daily prayer life. We must stay tuned-in to God so we can hear His voice. We can speak the word of faith and see powerful things happen if we stay filled with the Holy Ghost. We need a restoration and renewal of His spirit everyday.

### Wednesday

Elder Matt Anderson preached "Dragging Chains Can Spark A Wildfire" from Acts 12:5-9. After God breaks chains in your life, leave them at the altar. If you drag them along with you it's damaging, like causing a forest fire. It can destroy everything—other people's lives, and even your own walk with God. After the chains are gone, the temptation will still be there, but if you have left the chains at the altar, God will give you strength to overcome that temptation.  
Elder Hannah Sandy preached "Taking Off Your Yoke" from Matthew 11:28-30. When problems start building up in our lives and the burden gets so great, we wonder how we'll be able to carry it all. Share the load with the Lord. He said, "For my yoke is easy, and his burden is light" (Matthew 11:30).
