Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our survey of the Book of Acts, covering much of chapter 18. Paul had departed from Athens and traveled to Corinth, where he met and joined up with Aquila & Priscilla (Christians, ministers, and tentmakers, like he was). Paul taught in the synagogue to both Jews and Gentiles that Jesus was the Messiah (i.e. Christ, the Anointed One). Silas and Timothy eventually joined them. When the Jews there opposed themselves by rejecting truth, Paul washed his hands of them and turned to Gentiles, teaching in a nearby house. Some people believed and were baptized. God spoke to Paul in a vision, encouraging him to be bold and continue to proclaim the truth. When the Jews tried to bring Paul up for charges before Gallio (the Roman deputy), that ruler refused to preside over a religious dispute. Their baseless accusation was that Paul was violating "the law." Paul was not in violation of Mosaic Law, nor in violation of secular Corinthian law. Those Jews had revealed a willingness to ignore God's word rather than seek the truth of the Bible. Paul taught on for 18 months before journeying elsewhere, including Ephesus, Antioch, the region of Galatia and Phrygia—finally meeting Apollos.

Sunday PM

Pastor Pascal Crites preached "Sometimes You Just Gotta Shout On Half" from Luke 10:30. As we journey through life, there'll be "Revival Takers" who will try to attack our mind/faith, and take whatever they can. Yet greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world. Revival Takers try to tell us that "it's not possible," that "the pastor's dream is too big" or "it's not going to happen." There are also "Revival Fakers" who look the part, but won't take part. They dress right and go to the right church, but aren't doing anything to save the lost. We need to be involved and help reach the lost. Luke's Good Samaritan represents the "Revival Makers." They declare, "It's going to happen!" A Revival Taker spreads gossip, denigrating the pastor. A Revival Faker will dress holy in church and be worldly out of church. In church he'll say, "Praise the Lord," but then speak against you when he's away. The Revival Makers are ethical and believe God. They shout (praises) on "half"!

Wednesday

Elder Kieran Joseph preached "Have You Forgotten?" from Exodus 3:1-14. The devil loves to remind us of the imperfections of our past. We don't feel worthy. It's then we need to remember how Jesus died and shed His blood so our sins can be washed away. His mercy is overwhelming! We must continue to live holy everyday. Don't ever forget how great and awesome our God is!
Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Keep The Fire Burning" from Acts 2:1-4. We need to let the fire of the Holy Ghost fall in every church service. There's something about the Holy Ghost. You can't hold it in. You can't keep silent. Let it burn so bright inside of you that it will shine to the people around you. Grab ahold of this fire, and let's win Clarksburg and all of the communities around us.

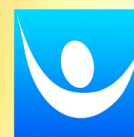
