### Sunday AM - cont. of Survey of the Book of Acts (chapters 18b & 19a)

This installment by Pastor Joseph was titled, "Baptized Unto What?" To say "Christ" (Greek) is to say "Messiah" (Hebrew) meaning "Anointed" (or "Anointed One"). Down through history there have been several that God anointed with His Spirit for a certain purpose or task—various "anointed ones." Yet Jesus is the ultimate "Anointed One," total fulfillment of Messianic prophecy. Jesus is not just "a messiah," He is "The Messiah" and the human manifestation of God. He is a new federal head for mankind. Moses (an earlier messiah) led the Israelites and they were "baptized unto Moses" in the Red Sea. The biblical concept is to follow the Anointed into covenant, and faithfully obey. "John the Baptist" baptized, yet declared he was not that Christ, who was to come later. He prepared his followers to accept Jesus as the Christ and be baptized "unto" Him. When Paul met disciples of John he asked two key questions: "Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed?" (no), then "Unto what then were ye baptized?" All who have been baptized unto Christ should be filled with His Spirit and be in covenant with Him.

### Sunday PM

Pastor Scott Ardary preached "Protect Your Investment" from I Peter 5:8-9. The attack of the adversary is a very common thing. We should be alert at all times because the devil is as a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour. We must have our spiritual armour on and be ready when the devil steps up to attack. Some people let their guard down – they quit fasting and praying – and the devil gets in. He is constantly looking, every hour and every day, for somebody with a weakness in their life. People leave the church because they want to have fun. The best joy we can have is when we lift our hands, pray, and rejoice in the Lord. We have to discipline ourselves and bring our humanity under subjection daily. As we embark on this journey of church growth, we must follow the vision of our leader. We must know who are leader is. Don't be contrary to what the leader says. Acknowledge that we are not infallible. We can all fall to temptation if we have not fully committed our lives to God. We must protect who we are. We must protect holiness, righteousness, and our ethical standard of living. Pray daily for our pastor and protect our brothers and sisters in the Lord. Pray, pray, pray!

Elder Matt Anderson preached "Do You Know Who Jesus Really Is?" from Matthew 8:28-33. One can read the Bible and "learn about" Jesus without truly "knowing" Him. Some get caught up in this life and lose focus of what really matters, but we must know Jesus personally, and have a relationship with Him. Elder Les Benedum preached "It's God's Will, Not God's Will" from I Timothy 2:3-5. It is God's will that men turn from their wicked ways and serve Him, yet He gives free will to us. We must choose to obey God. We can either choose to obey the will of God for our lives or not. May we ever pray, "not my will but thine!"

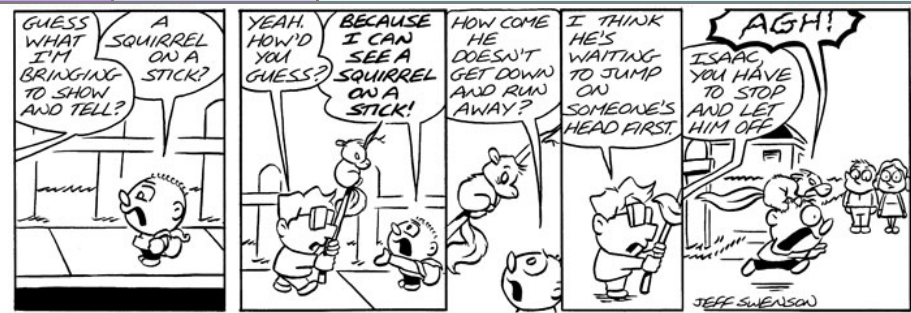
