Sunday AM - (Continuation of the study of the book of Acts)

Pastor Joseph preached "Arrival and Arrest" from Acts 9:13-16. God has a goal for each of us that's more important than material blessings in the here and now. God's ultimate goal for us is to make us mature for service throughout eternity. He needs people who He will be able to trust. God's trustworthy saints are willing to suffer for His name's sake or even die for Him if necessary. Paul had prophetic warnings that an ill fate awaited him at Jerusalem. God's will for Paul was that he speak the truth of the Gospel before Jews, Gentiles, and kings. Paul was willing to not only suffer but also to die for the Lord to bring God's will to pass. The disciples of the first century rejoiced when they were counted worthy to suffer for His name's sake. Our primary focus is on God's goal for us for eternity and where He's taking us, and what He wants to do with us in this life to bless and to reach souls. God blesses us in our lifetime, but we should use our blessings to help for the furtherance of His kingdom. Just as Paul was willing to suffer for God, we must be willing to suffer persecution and love both the fellowship and the lost.

Missionary Nancy Mansfield ministered to us about life in Jordan. When missionaries first went there, God answered prayer and opened doors for them. The government gave them permission to have a legally recognized church and promised to protect them (a miraculous thing in a Muslim-majority nation). Praise God! He is building churches in Jordan for His name's sake. The missionaries now have a vision on how to reach different people groups. They want to ensure that in case the government would ever not let Americans reside in the country that there are men/women there who will be pillars and strong, sure foundations in the churches and continue His work there. God reaches to people who are down in a pit, dirty and really messed up. We serve a God who doesn't mind reaching down when we need His help. Lost people can realize that there's something wrong in their lives and try desperately to save themselves and find they can't. Then they cry out "Help me!" Are we there to help them? Jesus came to seek and to save those who are lost. Now He's told us to go preach and help people even as I did.

Elder Brian Murphy Jr. preached, "I Am a Levite" from Numbers 2:3-34. It was the Levites job to offer sacrifices to God. We are by spiritual adoption and new covenant identity a Levite. We have been called to walk in newness of life. God has called us to be "a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people" (I Peter 2:9). There is no room in the holy of holies for belittling one another, or jealousy, bitterness, etc. It's our job to take care of the things of God. We must not let the things of this life influence us because we are to be a separate people. We need to be prayer warriors, people who will call out to God for souls. We need to be worshippers. We need to give God our everything. Be a living sacrifice.

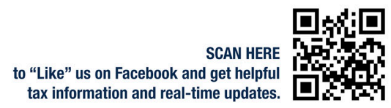
