Resurrection Sunday AM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "P.U.S.H." from Matthew 11:12 & 28:6. Jesus said, "the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force." One part of this statement's meaning seems to involve the fact that God allows us to "push" our way into His kingdom even though we don't deserve salvation. How does a lost soul "push" their way in? By following the plan of salvation laid out by Jesus. He told Nicodemus "Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God" (John 3:5). Seven weeks after Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, on the Feast Day of Pentecost, Peter preached, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 2:38). This is how we push our way in: 1. Repentance (dying to sin), then 2. Burying our former lifestyle of sin in a watery grave by water baptism in Jesus name, then 3. God gives us the power to live a new life by baptizing us with the Holy Ghost. This is being born of water and born of the Spirit. We've got to make up our mind that we are going to P.U.S.H. — Pray Until Something Happens. Push in prayer, fasting, faithfulness, worship, and studying God's Word. God rewards those who diligently seek Him.

Resurrection Sunday PM

Guest Pastor Pascal Crites preached "In Blood Covenant With Almighty God" from Genesis 17:1-7, 10, 13-15, 24, 27 & Colossians 2:9-12. God gave mankind freedom of will, and Adam and Eve made wrong choices, cursing humanity. This sin was passed through the generations. God promised Abram that if he would keep His covenant, then through him all nations would be blessed. Natural circumcision was an essential token of the Old Covenant. Now, water baptism in Jesus name is the corresponding essential token of the New Covenant. This "new" meaning was brought by God through John the Baptist and our Lord Jesus Christ, through His blood sacrifice on Calvary. By obeying Acts 2:38, we are entered together into a blood covenant of faith, bonded with God and Abraham, of whom we become adopted children by faith. We honor and fear God more than man. Let us to stay true to the covenant, keeping separate from sin, in dedication to God. "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate" (II Cor. 6:17).

Wednesday – Youth Service

Bro. Eric Hopkins preached "Is Today That Day?" from Matthew 11:12. We are living in a world where sin abounds—people are turning away from God more and more. The church needs to have more prayer. We need to be consistent, intense, passionate and thus "violent" in our prayer life. We must know how to shake hell and reach Heaven with our prayers. We have authority over anything that comes against us if we have the Holy Ghost. We must be radical and extreme in our commitment to praise. Today is the day that we need to be intense in prayer, worship, studying God's Word and every aspect of our church life.


