## Sunday AM – Continuation of our Survey of the Book of Acts

Pastor Doug Joseph taught from Acts chapter 27. The Apostle Paul was being taken as a prisoner by ships to Rome. At one point he warned the centurion that they would be in danger if they sailed during the stormy season, but the centurion listened to the owner of the ship instead. (Professionals know a lot, but they don't know the future. God does know the future). They sailed, and soon a storm arose that made sailing impossible. The wisdom of God seems like foolishness to the world, but if you listen to God you'll be safe. Whenever God tells you what the future holds and it's contrary to what professionals tell you, listen to the voice of God. People would be spared many heartaches and problems in this life if they would listen to God's voice. The storm waged on and on. When it seemed like all hope was gone, Apostle Paul told them to cheer up because, if they would listen to him this time, that none of them would die. They obeyed, and were saved, albeit cast upon a certain island in shipwreck. No matter what personal shipwreck you are suffering, God is with you and will bring you through it all. Trust Him!

## Sunday PM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "Secrets of Success" from II Samuel 5:19 & 23-25. As a church we should be willing to give people a second chance if they have repented and want to live a clean life. We must be dedicated to seeking God for direction and wisdom. **Secret #1: encourage oneself in the Lord.** Even though things in your life are upside down right now, God can bring you through. **Secret #2: inquire of the Lord** about life decisions. We must be sensitive to the voice of the Lord and follow His advice. **Secret #3: Don't be greedy.** Be fair to others, even at your own hurt. **Secret #4: Don't be bitter!** Be determined that even if you are justified in being bitter, you won't be bitter. As believers we must be in unity in the work of the Lord. As long as you live, you're going to have problems, even while serving God. Keep serving the Lord. Always inquire of the Lord for direction in your life. We can obtain these key elements from God's answers to us: **(1) direction, (2) strategy, (3) the right place, and (4) the right timing!**

## Wednesday

Youth Pastor Rusty Sandy preached, "God is Fighting For Us" from Acts 16:25-26. The world is in chaos, but God is fighting for us. You may have bad situations in your life or a bad doctor's report, but just give it to God and let Him fight for you. Just give God control over your problems and He will bring you through. There is no limit to what God can do for us. God is the way-maker. He's a miracle worker. God is building an army with our young people to reach many souls. We're going to have a great revival. Through it all, be very careful. There's so much in the world that could potentially distract us. Stand firm and work for God's kingdom. Seek Him for all your needs. He's fighting for you! 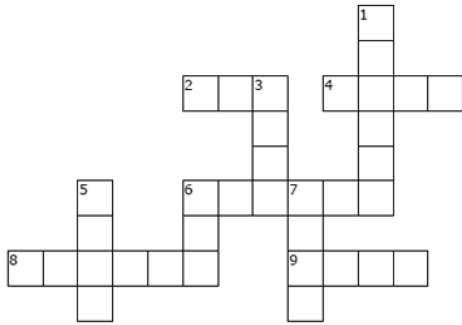

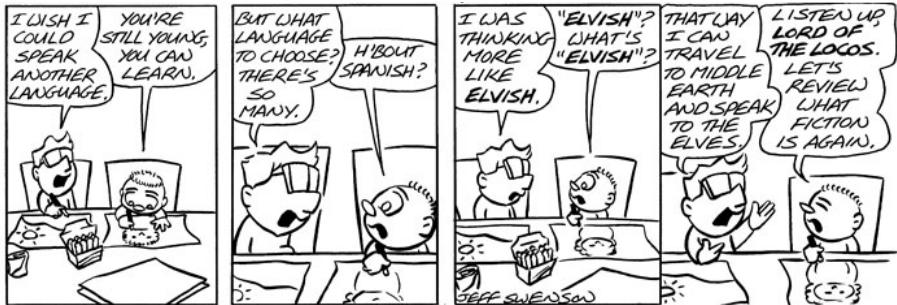

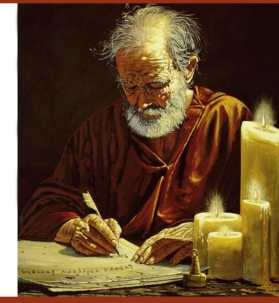
