Sunday AM – Conclusion of the Survey of the Book of Acts

Pastor Doug Joseph preached “Beyond the Non-Ending: A study of Acts 28 and what might have been next for ‘Paul & team.’” Paul vividly portrayed being completely sold out to God and to reaching the lost with the gospel. After he was shipwrecked on the island of Melita, he was bitten by a poisonous snake that he had accidentally picked up. He shook it off into the fire and suffered no harm. (See the signs of a believer in Mark 16.) After traveling on several ships and preaching the gospel on the way, they finally arrived in Rome. Paul was permitted to live in a rented home, under guard. He told the Jewish leaders there that he was a prisoner because of faith in “the hope of Israel” (Messiah, Bible prophecies of which Jesus fulfilled). After two years of preaching the kingdom of God, he was apparently released, and seems to have then had a fourth missionary journey, visiting Spain and several other places, before finally being arrested again. On his second incarceration in Rome, things were much different, as Nero had Paul beheaded for his faith in Jesus. (Nero also had Peter crucified for his faith in Jesus.)

Sunday PM

Evangelist Andy Gregg preached “Destroying Darkness” from Genesis 1:1-3 & John 1:1-5. In the beginning God created Light, which destroys darkness. Darkness is subject to light. When the devil is trying something in your life and God shows up, the devil has to flee. Darkness cannot be where light is. We who have been baptized in Jesus’ name and filled with the Holy Ghost are in the light. Fall in love with God. Surrender your all to God, and follow Him with all your heart, mind, body, and soul. His favor is with those who are faithful to Him. God is in control, not the things of this world. We don’t have to worry about our food or our clothes because God is in control and takes care of us. Sell out to God!

Jr. Elder Caleb Colombo preached “My Broken Understanding” from Proverbs 3:5-8. Even when we feel the devil is kicking us around, trust in the Lord. It will equip us to overcome temptations and difficulties of life. Jesus prayed and interceded exceeding sorrowful. He knew what the crucifixion was going to bring. If you knew tomorrow was going to bring a tragedy to your life, how would your prayer life be? How is your walk with God? How is your prayer life?

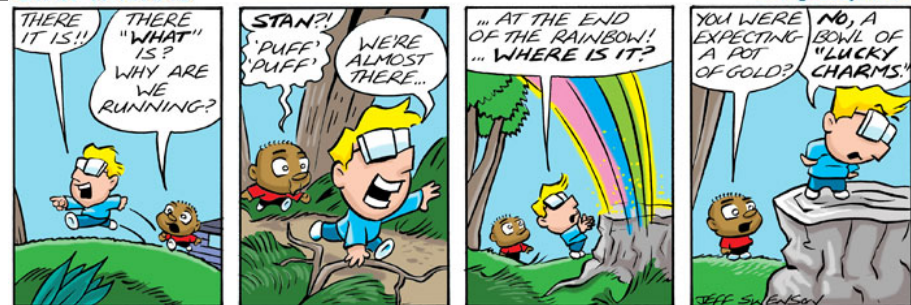

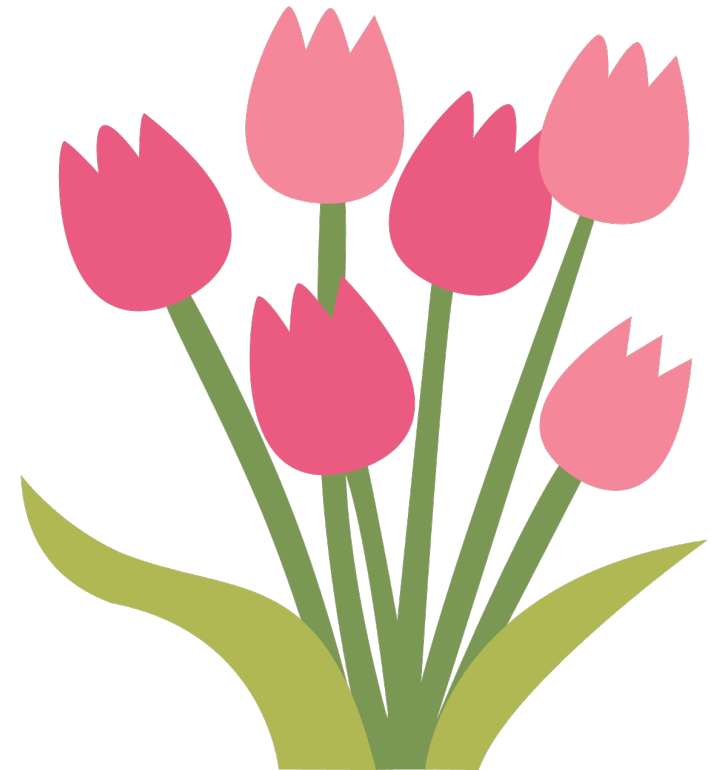
