### Sunday AM – Mother's Day

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "Faith of Our Mothers" from II Timothy 1:3-5. There's an epidemic of fatherlessness in America. Too many young males have had no man to model proper manhood for them, so they lack wisdom and rather than becoming men, they remain boys in adult bodies. They don't serve as fathers to the kids they conceive. By contrast, females usually have a quality of love and nurturing that permits girls to become women and mothers. Women and men have different roles in marriage and the family, and women have a greater capacity than men to nurture and care for others. When a young female lacks teaching, and when facing great pressure during a pregnancy out of wedlock, including pressure from parents or friends, or (often) from the father of the child, she may capitulate and get an abortion, and thus face a lifelong guilt and other detriments. Yet more often, even when a girl hasn't been properly taught womanhood/mothering, often she can somehow find her way to transition from girlhood to womanhood, and can successfully become a caring wife and mother. Mothers have a special bond with their children. Because women are emotionally more connected than men, often they can remember more details than men, over time. While a single mother cannot replace a father figure, there is hope that a godly mother can instill genuine faith in her children, even in her sons. Not much is known of Timothy's father, but Timothy was blessed with godly mother and grandmother, and the result was a genuine faith in him. Let's honor the faith of godly mothers, and stir up our gifts!

### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Buoyancy" from Psalm 133:1-3 & I Thess. 4:13-18. Buoyancy is a tendency to float in a fluid. God's anointing comes down to us from above, enabling us to rise in ways in which we'd normally sink! In the Rapture we will *rise*. While worldly people cannot be unified for good, we should be able to, because of God's touch! The church has many members that form one body. God's anointing flows where there is unity. We are the body of Christ and Jesus is the head of the body. If you are not in unity with the body, you are disconnected from the head! The source of anointing is the God that dwells in Messiah (Christ). If we are in the body of Christ and flow with unity we have the anointing to fulfill our purpose; be the church, be holy, called out and separate, be an ambassador for Christ. We are connected to the head through the new birth experience, dedication, sanctification, and holiness. "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:" (Colossians 2:9-10). God sends anointing downward and it causes the church to have a tendency to float upwards. If we stay committed to God we will have the buoyancy that allows us to love one another. It will allow us to flow with unity. We must get past our own carnality to maintain unity. We must rise above any evil that would come against us, and maintain a life connected to God.

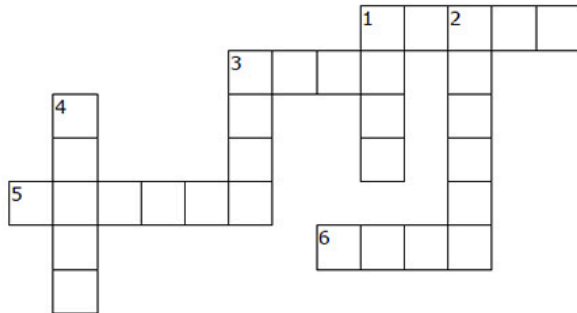
