Sunday AM – Father's Day

Pastor Joseph preached "Father of the Faithful" from Genesis 18:19. Abraham believed God. If you believe God, that faith results in God accounting or imputing His righteousness unto you. The Lord Jesus Christ took our sins upon Himself and died in our place on the cross of Calvary, paying our sin debt by taking our punishment. Unredeemed men cannot conceive of God as their friend because of their sins. The carnal mind cannot comprehend the things of God. Repentance is not a work that we do that earns us salvation. Repentance is a gift from God. He loved us so much that Jesus Christ, the human manifestation of God, laid down His life for us *while we were yet sinners*. God looked forward in time and saw us in our pre-redeemed state and knew we would need to have a relationship with Him. Sin separates us from God. It causes us to run away from God and hide. If you find yourself running away from God, push through to get the gift of repentance and allow God to get you past that sin curse. You and I can be a friend of God if we believe Him. Abraham was a friend of God and he was blessed to become the father of the faithful. Men, lead your family spiritually. Pray, fast, read your Bible, be faithful to church, and teach your children in family devotions. Be a man of God. You can leave an Apostolic legacy of spiritual leadership to your family.

Missionary Stephen Merritt preached "Broken & Perfect In The Valley" from Psalm 27:1-5. God is standing by our side in moments of uncertainty, confusion, betrayal and hurt, brokenness, and pain. He does His best work in us when we're in the valley, if we only allow Him. If we are determined and have a made up mind that we want to come out of our situation, our reactions must not be dictated by how we feel but what we know. We know that our God is a miracle worker. He looks at our valley situation. He knows the beginning and the end. He walks beside us in the valley. No eternal detriment will come to us. What a mighty God we serve! When we get our situation of brokenness into the presence of God we'll walk away with strength to overcome anything that may come in our life.

Wednesday

Jr. Elder Caleb Colombo preached "The Order of Importance" from Matthew 6:33-34. The most important thing in our life should be praying and seeking a relationship with God. We don't have to worry about our needs. God will take care of us. Anything we put before God will become a treasure. We cannot serve God and the world at the same time. Let serving God be your first priority in life. Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on Biblical Principles of Prophecy, using II Timothy 3:15 as his text. The lesson gave foundational understanding on how to interpret the Bible. For example, the Bible is to be interpreted according to a "plain sense" (literal reading), rather than as allegory, and figurative language is not allegory.

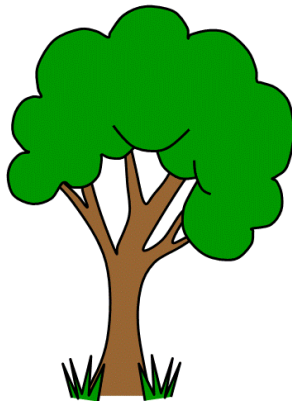
