Sunday AM

Pastor Doug Joseph taught Part 2 of "The Doctrine of the Bible." God's Word is true. Truth is absolute, precise, immutable, whole, consistent, eternal, unbreakable and irrevocable. God's Word has no error in it. The canon is all the books of the Old Testament and New Testament together as a complete library. It is the books recognized as inspired by God and accepted as Scripture. The Old Testament has four sections: Law, History, Poetry and Prophets. Jews recognize it as the Bible. Jesus and New Testament writers recognized it as Scripture. The New Testament has four sections: Gospels, History, Epistles and Prophecy. The only book in the latter category is the Book of Revelation. In it, the revelation of Jesus Christ is the most important revelation foretold. Epistles are letters written by apostles to the churches. The New Testament has apostolic authority. *Apostle* means "sent [one]." The apostles were sent to represent God in name, power, and authority. We believe on Jesus through the apostles' words. The canon stands complete. We "should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints" (Jude 3). The canon was originally written in Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek. Although the original manuscripts no longer exist, many manuscripts do, and because of divine preservation and careful scholarship we can affirm that for all practical purposes the transmitted, translated text communicates God's message to us. The Holy Ghost will help a believer interpret the Bible.

Sunday PM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "Line of Sight" from Matthew 6:22-23 & Psalm 32:8. You'd best be careful about where you're looking, because you'll go where you're looking. The eye is the light of the body. We must seek God's face if we want to be guided by His eye. Our natural eyes must behold a line of sight that makes it possible for us to stay focused on the face of God. Spiritually, we must guard the mind's eye of our heart. Physically we must be cautious of what we are looking at. If you get your eyes off of the Lord there is no limit to the destruction you can suffer. Get your natural eyes off of what you shouldn't be looking at and get them focused on the face of Jesus. Then, in the time of trouble He will hide you in His pavilion. Don't follow your own heart. Follow truth and seek after God.

Wednesday

Elder JT Sandy preached "Building on Treacherous Ground" from Matthew 7:24-27. We all have a spiritual house that we build. We are the temple of the Holy Ghost. We should not establish ourselves in a bad place, spiritually. We should not be laying our head to rest in treacherous conditions. Find a solid foundation in God—that will make or break you when the storms of life come. A solid foundation helps us talk, walk, dress, and act right. It's going to cost us something, but we must build our house on a rock/solid foundation. We cannot afford to be cheap. We must build on an unmovable, unshakable foundation.

Elder Baron Claypool preached "The Power of Prevention" from I Samuel 17:34-35. You must build a strong foundation today for the storm that's coming tomorrow. We've got to be preemptive in our walk with God. We must be vigilant and keep praying and fasting. We must guard ourselves against the enemy. God wants us to dig deeper in our walk with God.
